- Grown at 1800-2200 metres above sea level in nutrient-rich, volcanic soil.
- 85+ score (graded: 'Excellent') on the Specialty Coffee Association quality scale
- Only 6% of the world's coffee is graded as 'specialty'. So when we say you're drinking some of the finest coffee in the world, we mean it.



SOURCED ETHICALLY

By building long-term relationships built on trust and mutual respect, we actively support the livelihoods of the smallholder farmers we source our coffee from. Our farmers receive:

- Above-market prices for the coffee they sell us
- Trainings on best farming practices and financial literacy to maximise income
- Over \$11,000 in interest-free loans in 2023 to provide access to crucial finances needed for coffee farming.
